ACCRA, 3RD JANUARY, 2023 – In view of the COVID-19 situation in China, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Regional Integration wishes to advise the general public to take necessary precautions when travelling to China. As much as possible, only essential travel should be undertaken, until further notice.

Furthermore, Government has decided that, with effect from Friday 6th January, 2023, all persons travelling from China to Ghana will now have to produce a 48 hour negative PCR test and undergo mandatory antigen testing at the point of entry free of charge until further notice.
